"Liver transplantation (LT) in South Korea differs markedly from that in Western countries in terms of etiology and method. The rate of living donor liver transplantation (LDLT) is more than twofold higher than that of deceased-donor LT (DDLT). South Korea has the largest number of living donors per million people among Asia-Pacific countries and ranks second worldwide in terms of the number of living donors per million people (IRODaT 2019)..."
