

Abstract submission guidelines, Spring Meeting, March 23-24, 2017

Please read the following rules before submitting your abstract:

- Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- Please do not use first (given) names in list of authors.
- Please do not mention the name of the institute within the abstract text. This will result in immediate rejection.
- Titles are limited to 300 characters and abstracts to 2700 characters (spacing included). Check the length of your abstract in MS Word before using the abstract submitter.
- Abstracts are supposed to contain the goal of the research project followed by a description of methods, results and conclusions.
- Do not use special headings such as 'Methods', 'Results' or 'Discussion'. If the heading 'Conclusion' is to be used it should be placed without spacing in the beginning of a new line.
- The use of charts in the abstract is not allowed. The use of references are discouraged.
 Please check special characters (≥ μ γ α β ≤ ® ± ™ and sub- and superscript) from getting lost when copying your text to online abstract submission form.
- Always make sure to check the final abstract which you will receive by e-mail after submission.

Further information:

- Abstracts will be prioritized on the basis of scientific value and are allocated to oral presentations in one of the conference sessions.
- It is the policy of the NGVE/NVH/NVMDL to ensure independence, objectivity, and scientific rigor of all presented research, including pure academic research as well as research in collaboration with pharmaceutical companies. In case the committee is not convinced, abstracts may be rejected.
- By ticking the box, you certify that you as presenting author of this abstract, are the primary investigator. When this is not the case, you certify that you are not the primary investigator of this abstract, but have been given a mandate from the study group to present the data. In the latter case, it is obligatory to state below the abstract: 1. Name of the study group, 2. Name of the commercial partner, 3. Relation of the presenting author to the the studygroup (co-author/collaborating investigator, etc.).
- The data to be presented must oblige general accepted methodes of experimental design, data collection and analyses. Only generic names will be used. All recommendations involving clinical medicine activity must be based on evidence that is accepted within the profession of medicine as adequate justification for their indications and contraindications in the care of patients.
- If you want to submit an embargoed abstract we request to inform us by e-mail secretariaat@nvge.nl on the day of the submission. Please note that the accepted abstracts are made available to the public on the NVGE website six weeks in advance of the meeting.
- The presenting author should be available for presentation on both days of the congress. If an abstract is selected for presentation, registration as congress participant is required.
- Presentation guidelines are available on www.nvge.nl.
- If you want participation for the student award, you have to be in possession of a student identification card.
- All the abstracts will be placed on the website two weeks before the congress.
