UEG Journal Podcast

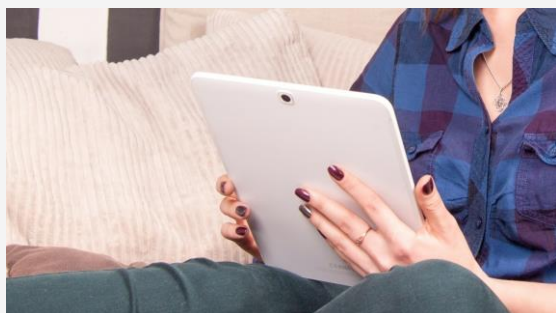
